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1. If the bidder is a Micro or Small Enterprise as per latest definitions under MSME rules, the bidder shall be exempted from the requirement of "Bidder Turnover" criteria and "Experience Criteria" subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. If the bidder is OEM of the offered products, it would be exempted from the "OEM Average Turnover" criteria also subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. In case any bidder is seeking exemption from Turnover / Experience Criteria, the supporting documents to prove his eligibility for exemption must be uploaded for evaluation by the buyer.
2. Preference to Make In India products (For bids < 200 Crore): Preference shall be given to Class 1 local supplier as defined in public procurement (Preference to Make in India), Order 2017 as amended from time to time and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Nodal Ministry for specific Goods/Products. The minimum local content to qualify as a Class 1 local supplier is denoted in the bid document. If the bidder wants to avail the Purchase preference, the bidder must upload a certificate from the OEM regarding the percentage of the local content and the details of locations at which the local value addition is made along with their bid, failing which no purchase preference shall be granted. 4. Purchase preference to Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs): Purchase preference will be given to MSEs as defined in Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bidder wants to avail the Purchase preference, the bidder must be the manufacturer of the offered product in case of bid for supply of goods. Traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises. In respect of bid for Services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid in respect of the offered product or service. If L-1 is not an MSE and MSE Seller (s) has/have quoted price within L-1+ 15% (Selected by Buyer) of margin of purchase preference /price band defined in relevant policy, such Seller shall be given opportunity to match L-1 price and contract will be awarded for 25%(selected by Buyer) percentage of total QUANTITY.

Part Quantity Bidding

Buyer has allowed part quantity bidding, bidders can offer maximum quantity that they can deliver keeping in mind their capacity and delivery period requirements. The offer quantity has to be more than minimum bid quantity as specified by the Buyer in the bid. Offers with quantity less than Minimum are liable to be rejected. It may however be noted that there is no guarantee that full offer quantity will be ordered by the buyer. Quantity to be ordered by the buyer will depend on various factors including the Ranking of the bidder, Offered quantity, Splitting criteria indicated by the buyer in the bid and the requirement of the buyer to have multiple sources of supply for ensuring supply chain etc. Sellers would be notified about likely order quantity or range of possible order quantity at the time of price match request made by the buyer. ward of contract will be subject to acceptance of price match request along with min / max offer quantity as decided by the Buyer.

5. Estimated Bid Value indicated above is being declared solely for the purpose of guidance on EMD amount and for determining the Eligibility Criteria related to Turn Over, Past Performance and Project / Past Experience etc. This has no relevance or bearing on the price to be quoted by the bidders and is also not going to have any impact on bid participation. IV. Special Instruction to Tenderers (SIT)

The following Special Instructions to Tenderers will apply for this purchase. These special instructions will modify/ substitute/ supplement the corresponding General Instructions to Tenderers (GIT) incorporated in Section II. The corresponding GIT clause numbers have also been indicated in the text below :

In case of any conflict between the provisions in the GIT and that in the SIT, the provisions contained in the SIT shall prevail :

i. **EMD (GIT Clause 18.3):** Rs.1,38,000/-

ii. **Parallel Contracts :** (GIT Clause No.43) IGM, Mumbai reserves its right to conclude Parallel contracts, with more than one bidder (for the same tender). The Parallel Contracts would be concluded as given below subject to alternate bidder matching the Prices with lowest bidder :

i. In case of splitting it shall be done in the ratio of 70:30 respectively or spare supply capacity.

ii. L1 shall be awarded at least 70% mentioned above or his spare supply capacity whichever is lower and

iii. For the rest of the contract quantity, the lowest rate accepted will be counter offered to the L2 party. On acceptance of the counteroffer, the order will be placed on L2 for 30% or the spare supply capacity of the L2 bidder which is lower and so on to other tenderers. In case of non-acceptance of the counteroffer by L2 party, similar offer shall be made to L3 and L4 and so on.

iv. For MSE firms, Parallel contract is applicable as per MSME guidelines issued time to time.

iii. **Evaluation of Bids:** As per Clause No. 2.8.4 Procurement Preference for MSE point no. (vii) MSE quoting price within price band L1 + 15% may be awarded 25% of the total tendered value provided they agree to match the L1 price. In case of more than one such eligible MSE, 25% quantity is to be distributed proportionately among these bidders. Within this, a purchase preference of 4% is reserved for MSEs owned by SC / ST entrepreneurs' and 3% is reserved for procurement from MSEs owned by women (if they participate in the tender process and match the L1 price, considering spirit of policy for enhancing the Govt. procurement from MSE.

V. Special Conditions of Contract (SCC)

The following Special Conditions of Contract (SCC) will apply for this purchase. i. **Option Clause:** The Purchaser, I.G. Mint, Mumbai reserves the right to increase the ordered quantity by 25% at any time till the final delivery date of the contract by giving reasonable notice even though the quantity ordered initially is supplied in full before the last date of delivery period.

ii. **Terms and Mode of Payments: (GCC Clause No. 22.3, 22.3, 22.6)**

Payment will be made by IGM, Mumbai on monthly basis after Receipt and Acceptance of Good certified by competent authority and production of all required documents.

iii. **Terms of Delivery(GCC clause No.10)** – a. Contract period will be for one year.
