3. Financial Standing:

i. V. Special Conditions of Contract (SCC)

- 1. **Raw Material:** The QA Raw material required for making 30,000 pieces of QA blanks the form of ingots/sci ssile, rejected blanks etc., is to be lifted by the vendor from India Govt. Mint, Kolkata (i.e. depending on the ava ilability of QA Raw Material).
- 2. **Packing :** (GCC Clause No.8) -Packing to be done for individual blanks basis to avoid any scratch during transi t. The blanks should be packed in such a manner that they are not exposed to open atmosphere during the tran sportation. The packing provided by the supplier should be strong and durable enough to withstand, without lim itation, the entire journey during transit including transhipment (if any), rough handling, open storage etc witho ut any damage deterioration etc. As and if necessary, the size weight and volumes of the packing cases shall al so take into consideration, the remoteness of the final destination of the goods and availability or otherwise of t ransport and handling facilities to all points during transit upto final destination as per the contract.
- 3. Terms of Delivery: (GCC Clause No.10)
 - a) 5000 QA blanks to be supplied every month. Raw Material required for making QA blanks is to be lifted fro m IGM-Kolkata.
 - b) Entire quantity blanks is to be delivered at IGM Mumbai within six months from the date of Purchase Order
- 4. **Warranty**: (GCC Clause No.16) Warranty shall remain valid for twelve months after goods or any portion ther eof as the case may be, have been delivered to the final destination. Such warranty shall not apply for any blank s which may get damaged due to mishandling at the MINT and/or during the subsequent stamping process.
