1. If the bidder is a Micro or Small Enterprise as per latest definitions under MSME rules, the bidder shall be exempted from the requirement of "Bidder Turnover" criteria and "Experience Criteria" subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. If the bidder is OEM of the offered products, it would be exempted from the "OEM Average Turnover" criteria also subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. In case any bidder is seeking exemption from Turnover / Experience Criteria, the supporting documents to prove his eligibility for exemption must be uploaded for evaluation by the buyer.

2. If the bidder is a Startup, the bidder shall be exempted from the requirement of "Bidder Turnover" criteria and "Experience Criteria" subject to their meeting of quality and technical specifications. If the bidder is OEM of the offered products, it would be exempted from the "OEM Average Turnover" criteria also subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. In case any bidder is seeking exemption from Turnover / Experience Criteria, the supporting documents to prove his eligibility for exemption must be uploaded for evaluation by the buyer.

3. Preference to Make In India products (For bids < 200 Crore): Preference shall be given to Class 1 local supplier as defined in public procurement (Preference to Make in India), Order 2017 as amended from time to time and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Nodal Ministry for specific Goods/Products. The minimum local content to qualify as a Class 1 local supplier is denoted in the bid document. If the bidder wants to avail the Purchase preference, the bidder must upload a certificate from the OEM regarding the percentage of the local content and the details of locations at which the local value addition is made along with their bid, failing which no purchase preference shall be granted. In case the bid value is more than Rs 10 Crore, the declaration relating to percentage of local content shall be certified by the statutory auditor or cost auditor, if the OEM is a company and by a practicing cost accountant or a chartered accountant for OEMs other than companies as per the Public Procurement (preference to Make-in -India) order 2017 dated 04.06.2020. Only Class-I and Class-II Local suppliers as per MII order dated 4.6.2020 will be eligible to bid. Non - Local suppliers as per MII order dated 04.06.2020 are not eligible to participate. However, eligible micro and small enterprises will be allowed to participate .The buyers are advised to refer the OM No.F.1/4/2021-PPD dated 18.05.2023.

4. Purchase preference will be given to MSEs having valid Udyam Registration and whose credentials are validated online through Udyam Registration portal as defined in Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bidder wants to avail themselves of the Purchase preference, the bidder must be the manufacturer / OEM of the offered product on GeM. Traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises and hence resellers offering products manufactured by some other OEM are not eligible for any purchase preference. In respect of bid for Services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid in respect of the offered product or service and Buyer will decide eligibility for purchase preference based on documentary evidence submitted, while evaluating the bid. If L-1 is not an MSE and MSE Seller (s) has / have quoted price within L-1+ 15% (Selected by Buyer) of margin of purchase preference /price band defined in relevant policy, such MSE Seller shall be given opportunity to match L-1 price and contract will be awarded for 100% (selected by Buyer) percentage of total quantity. The buyers are advised to refer the OM No. F.1/4/2021-PPD dated 18.05.2023 [OM No.1 4 2021 PPD dated 18.05.2023](#) for compliance of Concurrent application of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises Order, 2012 and Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India) Order, 2017. Benefits of MSE will be allowed only if seller is validated on-line in GeM profile as well as validated and approved by Buyer after evaluation of documents submitted.

I. Pre-Qualification/Eligibility Criteria

1. Experience & Past Performance :-

The bidder (manufacturer or principal of authorized representative – hereinafter referred simply as ‘The Bidder’) shall be a manufacturer that has regularly for at least the last three years manufactured, supplied, erected, commissioned PLC with the same or higher specifications of at least one number in last five years ending on 31.03.2024. At least one number of the product offered for supply should be in successful operation for at least one year on the date of bid opening.

2. Capability - Equipment & Manufacturing Facilities:-

The Bidder must have an annual capacity to manufacture and supply at least 1 nos. of PLC.

3. Financial Standing:

- i. The average annual financial turnover of the bidder firm (manufacturer or principal of authorised dealer) during the last three years, ending on 31.03.2024 should be at least Rs.33,56,402/- as per the annual report (audited balance sheet and profit & loss account) of the relevant period, duly authenticated by a Chartered Accountant/Cost Accountant in India.
- ii. The net worth of the Bidder Firm should not be negative on 31.03.2024 and should not have eroded by more than 30% in the last three years, ending on 31.03.2024.

Note for Bidders:

- i. For MSE & start up (registered for the tendered item all financial criteria shall be exempted. However its capacity & capability may be verified (if necessary) by the IGM, Mumbai.
- ii. ‘Doctrine of Substantial Compliance’: The Pre-Qualification Bidding (PQB) and Pre-Qualification Criteria (PQC) are for shortlisting of sources who are competent to perform this contract to ensure best value for money from expenditure of Public Money. This process is neither intended to bestow any entitlement upon nor to create any rights or priv

illeges for the Bidders, by way of overly hair-splitting or viciously legalistic interpretations of these criteria, disregarding the very rationale of the PQB and PQC. Keeping this caveat in view, interpretation by Procuring Entity would be based on common usage of terminologies and phrases in public procurement in accordance with the 'Doctrine of Substantial Compliance' and would be final.

iii. Along with all the necessary documents/ certificates required as per the tender conditions, the bidder should furnish a brief write-up, backed with adequate data, explaining his available capacity (both technical and financial), for manufacture and supply of the required goods/ equipment, within the specified time of completion, after meeting all their current commitments.

iv. Supporting documents submitted by the bidder must be certified as follows:

v. All copy of supply/ work order; respective completion certificate and contact details of clients; documents issued by the relevant Industries Department; National Small Industries Corporation (NSIC); manufacturing licence, annual report, etc., in support of experience, past performance and capacity/ capability should be authenticated by the by the person authorised to sign the tender on behalf of the bidder.

vi. All financial standing data should be certified by certified accountants, for example, Chartered Accountants/ Cost Accountants in India and equivalent in relevant countries; and

vii. Indian bidder or Indian counterparts of foreign bidders should furnish their Permanent Account Number.

II. Undertaking:

- i. Undertaking for acceptance of all the terms and conditions of the GeM Bid including Buyer Added Bid Specific Terms and conditions without any deviation duly sealed & signed.
- ii. Undertaking of declaration that the bidder is not blacklisted/debarred for dealing by Government of India duly sealed & signed.

III. Delivery Period - Overall delivery period is 210 days after placement of Gem order as follows.

- i. Supply of material within 90 days from the date of Gem order for both machines.
- ii. Installation, Testing, Commissioning, FAT within 210 days from the date of Gem order for both machines.

IV. Payment Terms: Payments will be made in phased manner machine wise.

a. After successful completion of FAT of first machine 100 % payment for material and services provided for first machine.

b. After successful completion of FAT of Second machine 100 % payment for material and services provided for second machine.

V. Evaluation Method: The Total Price quoted shall be considered for evaluation & to decide L-1 bidder.

VI. Warranty: a) The Warranty shall remain valid for a period of twelve months from the date of final acceptance certificate issued by IGMM and shall include repairing and replacing of defective parts, workmanship, repairs/replacement/modification of software installed and services of the newly installed system, required operational and maintenance support services at free cost, which are essentially required to keep entire machine in normal operation.

b) IGMM shall promptly notify any claims arising under this warranty. Upon receipt of such claims/notice from IGMM, the successful bidder shall within a period of 48 hours repair or replace the defective goods or services or part thereof without any cost to IGMM.

VII. Performance Security Deposit: 5% of order value.

Note: Before issue of order on GeM on successful firm 'Notification of Award of contract' will be issued on firm duly requesting to deposit the performance security within 15 days.

VIII. Option Clause: The Purchaser reserves the right to increase/decrease the ordered quantity by up to 25% at any time, till final delivery date of the contract (or the extended delivery date of the contract), by giving reasonable notice even though the quantity ordered initially has been supplied in full before the last date of Delivery Period (or the extended delivery period of the contract).

13. Reference of conditions published on any external site or reference to external documents/clauses.
14. Asking for any Tender fee / Bid Participation fee / Auction fee in case of Bids / Forward Auction, as the case may be.

Further, if any seller has any objection/grievance against these additional clauses or otherwise on any aspect of this bid, they can raise their representation against the same by using the Representation window provided in the bid details field in Seller dashboard after logging in as a seller within 4 days of bid publication on GeM. Buyer is duty bound to reply to all such representations and would not be allowed to open bids if he fails to reply to
